

**REGISTRATION FOR PROXY ACCESS TO A CHILD'S ONLINE SERVICES**

If you are the parent, guardian or carer of a child and would like to have proxy access to the child's online services please complete this form with **your** details **and** the details of the **child** and give it to a member of our reception team together with **one proof of photo identification and one proof of address for yourself and one proof of identification for your child**. You do not need to provide an email address to use online services, however, provision of an email address greatly simplifies the registration and maintenance processes. Please note that proxy access to a child's online services terminates on the child's thirteenth birthday. Parents/carers cannot be granted proxy access to the online services of a child aged 13 years or older. If, from the age of 13 years, the child would like access to their own online services their competence to do so would need to be assessed by the child's GP.

## Online Services FAQs

Thank you for signing up for Springwood Surgery's online services provided by SystmOnline. You will soon\* be able to;

- Request repeat prescriptions for medication
- Book an appointment to see a GP or practice nurse
- View your test results
- View an abridged version of your medical record
- View your Summary Care Record (SCR)
- View which NHS organisations can access your medical record

If you have signed up for proxy access to a child's online services or the online services of an adult that you care for you will soon\* be able to do one or more of the following;

- Request repeat prescriptions for the person you care for
- Book an appointment for the person you care for to see a GP or practice nurse
- View the test results of the person you care for
- View an abridged version of the medical record of the person you care for
- View the Summary Care Record (SCR) of the person you care for
- View which NHS organisations can access the medical record of the person you care for

A member of our reception team should have provided you with your SystmOnline account details. You can also receive your account details by email or SMS text message if you prefer.

You will be asked to change your password upon first login of the account. The Data Protection Act does not allow Springwood Surgery to keep a copy of your password. If you forget your password you can use the provided link to reset your password or contact Springwood Surgery and a member of the team will reset your account for you.

SystmOnline can be accessed directly at <https://systmonline.tpp-uk.com> or via the practice website at [www.springwoodsurgery.co.uk](http://www.springwoodsurgery.co.uk) A free app is also available from the App Store for Apple devices or the Google Play store for Android devices. Simply search for the app titled 'SystmOnline' or the app developer 'TPP'. Some content (e.g. medical record) is not available within the apps and you can only book an appointment up to 2 weeks in advance within the apps. If you would like to book an appointment further ahead we recommend that you access your online account via a web browser on your device. You can only access SystmOnline from within the UK.

Prescriptions can be requested up to 7 days in advance of the due date. For safety purposes the system will not allow you to order medication earlier than this. If you are unsure of the due date please check the repeat tick list which came with the previous prescription. If you require medication earlier, or a double supply is required due to going away on holiday for example, please use 'Medication request notes' below the list of regular medications and detail why the prescription is required earlier and we will endeavour to satisfy the request.

If during completion of the online services registration form a pharmacy of choice was specified all medication prescriptions will automatically be sent to that pharmacy. You can amend this within the online account should you or the person you care for change your mind(s) about the preferred pharmacy in the future.

*Please note that SystmOnline is a product of The Phoenix Partnership (TPP).
